COVID-19 Dashboard by the Center for Systems Science and Engineering (CSSE) at Johns Hopkins University





Data Revolution

- Data for better policymaking
 - There is a great opportunity for more effective policymaking if we use data to inform what we are doing.
- Data: the driver of productivity and prosperity
 - Our wellbeing depends on economic prosperity, which in turn depends upon exploiting our investment in data, and on our skills as a society to understand and use data.
- Data to strengthen democracy and trustworthiness
 - Our democracy relies on the quality and trustworthiness of data in the public domain.




With the fast establishment of various Data Science entities across campuses, industry, and government, there is a limited time window of opportunity for a successful transformation that we must not miss.



| Official Statistics | | Opaque procedures, not relying on methodological standards, not pursuing a common good | Methodological amateurs, particular and politically biased interests of social movements and specific parties |
| Big Data/IOT/AI | Inefficient, state dependent, applying old- fashioned methodologies, too slow in data proceeding / publication | | Naïve, because engaging for a common good and not for profit; limited by lack of access to data generating technologies |
| Civil Society | State centered and not providing data, relevant for contemporary social issues and civic concerns | Profit oriented and opaque, not linked to a common good, ignoring the imperative to justify measurement | |



On 12 July 2016, the Irish Central Statistics Office published its latest national accounts data for 2015, revealing that real GDP growth was up 26.3% from 2014 (and up 32.4% in current prices) These figures have attracted considerable attention in the international press, with commentators raising questions about their reliability and about the conceptual basis for the measurement of GDP.
